



## COMMUNITY CROSSROADS OUTREACH CENTER TO HOST COMMUNITY RESOURCE FAIR ON JULY 19

**FORT WORTH, TEXAS** (July 5, 2022) – Community Crossroads Outreach Center, the mission outreach center of First Presbyterian Church of Fort Worth, will host The Connect on Tuesday, July 19, 2022, from 9:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. The Connect (formerly Homeless Connect) is a resource and information fair, bringing area service agencies to an easily accessible central neighborhood location to connect with individuals and families.

Planned services available on July 19 will include vision and medical screenings, Covid-19 vaccines (adults and children), HIV/AIDS testing, pet services (companion pet sitting, vaccinations, food, spay/neuter services), haircuts, scan cards, bus passes, and magistrate services, in addition to other area service providers on site. A free lunch will be served in the Community Crossroads parking lot from 11:30 a.m. to 1 p.m. All Tarrant County residents interested in accessing these services are invited to attend.
